

# THEATRE CLASSES



## THEATRE 1

This is an intro course that covers many, many different areas of theatre, including acting, playwrighting, lights, sound, improv, construction, costumes, and more! At the end of the semester, the class creates a short production. This is a great first step in CHS Theatre since you'll experience lots of different topics.

## THEATRE 2

This class continues where Theatre 1 left off and goes more in-depth. At the beginning of the semester, we do a survey to find out areas of theatre the group would like to explore, and then we plan the class to match these interests. Theatre 2 may be repeated.

## TECHNICAL THEATRE

As part of the CHS Career Tech Education program, this class trains students for skills needed to be a technician in the entertainment industry, including topics such as lights, sound, construction, and props. The class also focuses on the skills of successful employees, like communication, collaboration, and creativity. This is a 2-year course beginning junior year.

## ADVANCED ACTING/DIRECTING

This class is geared toward students who have already shown success in acting or directing through CHS courses or participation in CHS Theatre productions. We focus on interpreting scripts, making strong acting and directing choices, and giving and accepting feedback. A.A.D. may be repeated, and honors credit is available through additional requirements.

## S.T.A.G.E.

Our drama club meets monthly for fun activities, and members participate in workshops, service projects, and our student-produced show, a production entirely directed, designed, and performed by students.

C.H.S. Troupe #2204 of the International Thespian Society recognizes students with exceptional dedication to theatre arts. Members and non-members attend large-scale festivals filled with performances, workshops, and students from everywhere!
